Cascade Clamp - Founded in Portland, Oregon in 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company started as a small machine store employing only four individuals. Total sales for that initial year amounted to about \$60,000. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless-steel valves, pipe fittings and different components. Through 5 years of operation, the business had expanded to 40 staff and their annual sales volume had increased to three hundred thirty thousand dollars. Nowadays, Cascade is amongst the top international producers in the material handling industry.

Design and manufacturing of the company's initial hydraulic cylinder allowed this young company to aggressively pursue better business opportunities. All through the last 60 years, the trade of material handling has developed into a very complex field with Cascade proudly playing a part in its improvement. Cascade presently continues to develop as the leader provider of forklift attachments and numerous related items. The company feels assured in their skill to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding buyer's needs in the future and remaining aggressive in the world market.

In the 1950's, Cascade started designing, manufacturing and promoting hydraulic accessories. Manufacturing was completed in the year 1956 on a brand new office to be able to accommodate all of the plant and office operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's present center of operations. Subsequent to fifteen years of business, total employees reached 180 employees and sales had reached nearly 2.3 million dollars.

In the year 1959 in Springfield, Visalia a second production facility was built. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's initial transfer into the global world of the material handling industry as the company established interest in England, Australia, and the Netherlands.

In the year 1964, the company altered its name to the Cascade Corporation. After that in 1965, the business went public with a preliminary offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. Ever since then the company has expanded its manufacturing facilities within the continental US to the locations Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already current plants in Springfield, Visalia and Portland, Oregon. Cascade products are fabricated globally because of lots of subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a new facility was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European head office. This plant is built to be the ultimate customer service centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in 1996 and the year 1997 after acquiring five companies, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the worldwide best in blades.
