

## Side Tilt Carriages

Side Tilt Carriages - There are actually 4 sizings of hook type fork carriages rated by the tine carriage lifting capacity. Hook type tine carriages have been standardized.

Class I carriages are rated for loads as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for Class I is 13 inches. Class II carriages are rated for loads as much as 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type tines could be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted blades can vary by the amount of offset between the tine eye and the tine. Carriage capacity would be established by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
